In case you somehow missed it —

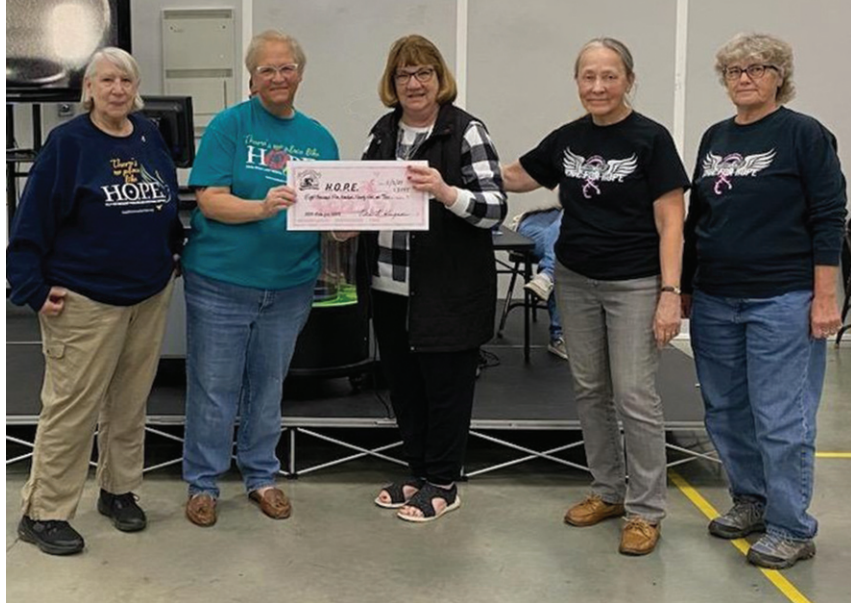
On November 3 the Twin Rose Lady Riders presented Barb with checks totaling \$8595 from this year's event. WOW.

Treasurer Lynn is out of town but reported that we have a good balance in the bank (see her for those exact details) and all checks recently written have cleared.

Nat will follow up on audit results.

OLD BUSINESS - 2024 Recap

Ride For HOPE –

- Each year fewer riders register [See chart from last 8-yrs]
- Eisenhauer's has agreed to host us again next year but that location is not etched in stone
- HOPE's thank you letter sent to donors mentioned a total \$25 less than we gave them. Nat will look into the discrepancy.
- Nat will remind Bernie to create the dangly thingy for Red Rose Riders.

Monthly Rides –

Dawn H suggested only having Sunday rides for consistency; other Roses like some on Saturdays especially because some destinations are not open on Sundays; Ride Committee will discuss.

NEW BUSINESS

2025 Ride for HOPE, Sept. 20 –

- After 28 years Sue & John have retired from routing/liming [see Nov newsletter]; Ride Committee will step in.
- Kathy R suggested it be renamed a Road Rally to encourage more 4-wheelers.
- Kathy M says Red Rose Riders liked YMC location better because there was a place to sit and socialize; was suggested that we set up a separate tent w/tables & chairs and offer pastries/drinks etc for sale.
- Option of led ride discussed again: WOW generally discourages this due to liability but does our AMA event insurance cover it? If so, there are still many regulations including the necessity for a leader, mid-pack rider, and sweep, all connected by radio and carrying a first aid kit. Would we have enough Roses to carry that off and run the event as well? Side-road blocking not allowed without police presence.
- Self-guided poker run route to HOPE Haven suggested but it is many miles round trip.
- Eisenhauer's is willing to donate a raffle item next year

-Event advertising discussed:

- Promote through WOW magazine; promote through MAWMR (FB page, flyers in goody bags, Barb to hype event at her table)
- Advertise in Thunder Road and other publications
- Distribute flyers at lots of Bike Nights
- Contact CanAm clubs, Jeep clubs
- Add QR code to route sheet linking to Google Maps to call out directions if folks fear following lime dots. Would need link.
- Must further emphasize who HOPE is and what they do.

- Roses could organize another Meet & Greet day

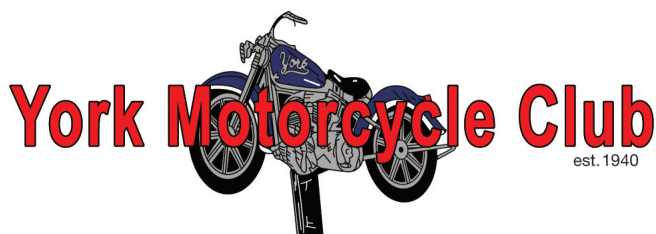
