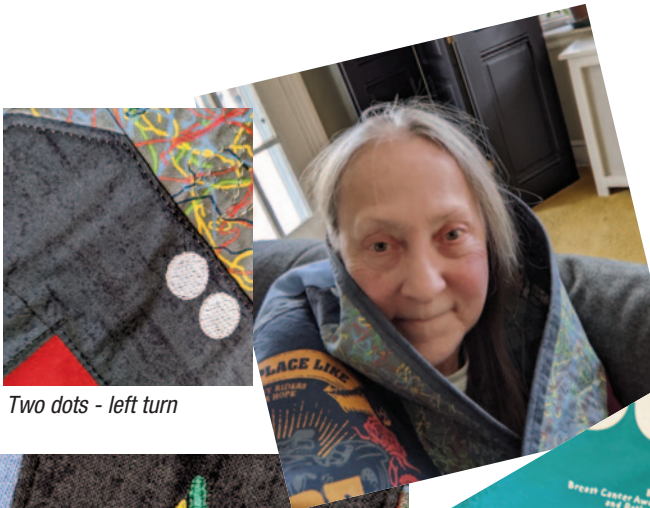

**Remembering the life of AMA Motorcycle Hall of Famer and trailblazer Mary McGee**

AMA Magazine did a wonderful retrospective on Mary's life — a life so unlikely and inspiring that a documentary has been filmed. Early on she enjoyed spectating at races so her brother Jim let her take his Porsche around the track. She won that first race and continued winning throughout the 1950s, ignoring the fact that women drivers were looked down on. "I was having too much fun."

Wanting to try racing on 2-wheels, she became the first woman to pass the American Federation of Motorcyclists test. Facing more gender discrimination, even though she had raced in the 150cc class for years, she was forced down to the 50cc class because she was a woman. Pressing on through the 1970s, she raced pavement, dirt and then sand — becoming the first *person* to finish the Baja 500 solo despite crashing into a cactus. "If I'm starting a race I'm going to finish." Motorcycle Mary McGee was a life-long ambassador and inspiration to all women who ride.
