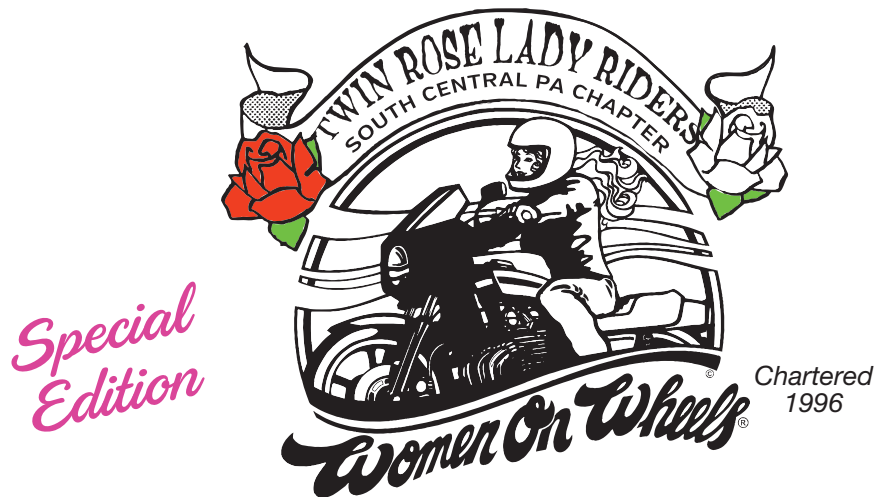

Lynn began by welcoming Kim to her first indoor meeting.

Lynn is taking care of our WOW Annual Chapter Report and Charter Renewal. TRLR proudly recruited 4 new members to WOW in 2017 bringing our roster up to 24.

Lynn & Dawn attended the AMA Dist. 6 sanction meetings. Our AMA dues have been paid and our 2018 Ride For HOPE has been officially scheduled for Oct. 7. This spring we will discuss whether to move the Ride for HOPE to a warmer month in 2019.

Event insurance will be purchased late in the summer. The rates have gone up, and unless AMA can negotiate a lower fee our cost will be \$190 (up from \$136).
