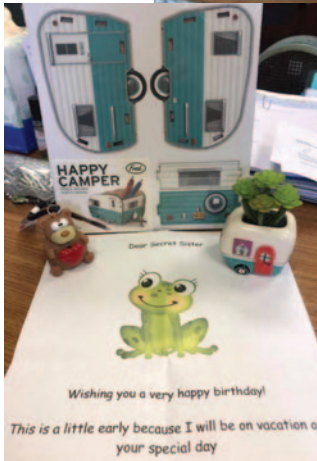

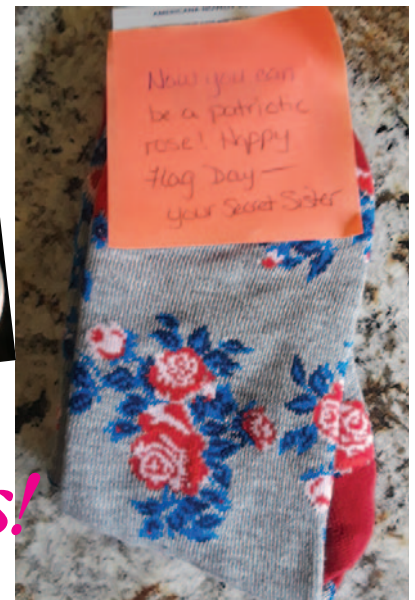

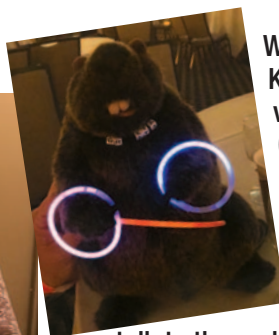
Sue W label. I guess our club just HAS to have triplets to feel complete...

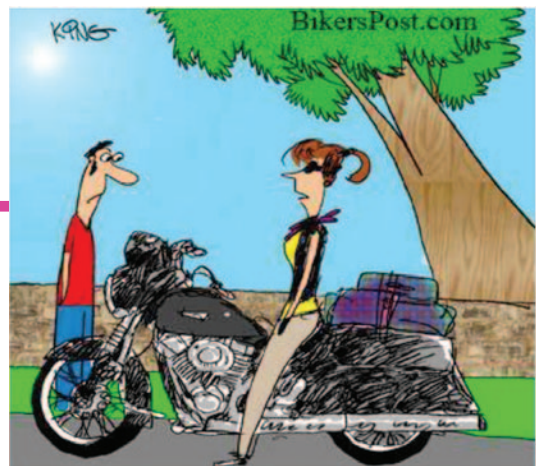
